Citizens Scholarships 2020 Application







\$6,000 Awarded to High School Graduates

Since 1990, Citizens Connected has been able to award scholarships for high school seniors whose parents, guardians, or foster parents have a minimum of telephone service with the Cooperative. Funds for these scholarships were obtained from unclaimed patronage refunds along with general funds. Current laws allow the Cooperative to use unclaimed patronage refunds to benefit students rather than lose the funds to the State Tax Department. This year Citizens Connected is giving four (4) \$1,500 scholarships to (4) 2020 high school graduates that permanently reside within our service area.

Eligibility

Applicants:

- Must be a 2020 high school graduate whose primary residence is within the Cooperative's service area
- Parent(s), guardian, or foster parents must be a member in good standing and have a minimum of telephone service for the past year with Citizens Connected.
- Must successfully complete the first semester of the 2020-21 school year at an accredited postsecondary college, university, vocational or technical institute and show proof of registration for the second semester before being eligible for the payment from Citizens Connected.

Application Instructions

Applicants must:

- Type or print all information
- Complete all items on the application (Incomplete applications will not be considered)
- Submit a copy of your transcript
- Submit a Senior picture for announcing the winners in the area newspapers (Please do not staple)
- Submit an essay entitled "Why I have chosen my field of choice and what I plan to accomplish in this field?" Essay Criteria: 500 word maximum, 12-point font, double spaced with one inch margins

A scholarship committee made of Cooperative Members (non-employees and board members) will review all scholarships weighted on the following criteria:

40% - Essays: 50% - Theme and content (Relevance and insight into the essay topic and thoroughness of presentation)

20% - Organization & Development (Clear & Logical development of essay)

20% - Grammar & mechanicals

10% - Style (Effectiveness & flow of writing)

30% - Letters of recommendations (up to 3 letters of recommendation from school faculty, Co-op member or employer)

30% - Community, volunteer & extracurricular activities
